

Dignitary Protection Course Objectives:

At the end of this training period, the student will be a basically-trained Dignitary Protection Agent.

He/she will be able to operate in a knowledgeable, professional manner in a VIP protective environment, ensuring that the student is a credit and an asset to himself/herself and their agency.

These proficiencies will include the following:

- Purpose, duties and assignments of protective details
- Knowledge of Rings of Security and Protocol
- Know what is and what makes up a protective advance
- Advancing a motorcade route
- Knowledge of Protective counter-measures
- Knowledge of what is and how to participate in a protective movement of the VIP
- How to operate and be qualified in the environment of the " Law Enforcement Officer Flying Armed" in civilian aviation
- How to get one's VIP out of harm's way expeditiously and safely using evacuation maneuvers.
- Knowledge of what a US Secret Service motorcade looks like and the make-up and position of the vehicles in case the student's assigned VIP is involved in a Presidential/Vice-Presidential motorcade.
