During the Officer Down / Mass Casualty Triage block of instruction, individuals will learn tactics and medical care techniques used to control major arterial bleeding, treating for shock, proper application of a tourniquet and many other skills needed to make a difference in life or death situations. Also covered is the vital triaging process for LE, which is designed to bridge the gap between LE and EMS.
