Tom attended US State Department Diplomatic Security School in 1996, CSP Dignitary Protection Training Class in 1998, The USSS' Governors Protection Seminar in 2005 and the TSA's Federal Air Marshal Service Civil Aviation Awareness training in 2005. In December of 2003 Tom was promoted to Sergeant and became a detail supervisor until retirement in 2011. Tom was also instrumental in building and facilitating CSP Executive Protection policy, training and operational procedures.

Joe Deedon:

Was employed as a Law Enforcement Officer with the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office, Colorado, from 08/2002 to 06/2010. He was a tactical operator with the Jefferson County Regional SWAT Team. In February of 2011 Joe completed a mission in Afghanistan with the Marine Corp as an Embedded Police Mentor. Since 2007 Joe has coordinated and taught several thousand hours of active shooter and SWAT training for various agencies nationwide.
