This sniper course is designed for new or entry level law enforcement/police snipers with the primary focus being the training and operation of a police sniper in an urban environment.

The Urban Operations for the Law Enforcement Sniper course is a 5 day, 40 hour course that incorporates updated techniques to stay ahead of the game. It is a physically demanding course designed to teach the sniper to perform mentally and physically while under stress.



Major areas of emphasis during this 40 hour course of instruction are:

- The Role of the Sniper**
- Proper Fit of Rifle and Zeroing**
- Marksmanship Fundamentals**
- Target Identification and Threat Discrimination**
- Use of Cover, Concealment and Building Use of, and live Fire from Urban Vehicle Hides**
- Positional and Unsupported Shooting**
- Use of Data Book Documentation**
- Communication**
- Ballistics and Barrier Shooting**
- Engaging Moving Targets**
- Numerous Courses of Live Fire and Scenario Based “blank” fire are incorporated during the week**
