Carbine Operator Course



Law enforcement agencies across the nation have begun to recognize the necessity for officers to be armed with a weapon that provides capabilities beyond the handgun or shotgun. This 24 hour, POST-approved Carbine Operator Certification course is designed to provide law enforcement officers the necessary skills to deploy with the law enforcement carbine as a duty weapon.

The student will develop a full understanding of the capabilities of the carbine, to include:

- Appropriate set up and accessories for the carbine
- Weapons maintenance
- Fundamentals of shooting
- Proper zeroing
- “Combat” shooting techniques
- Use of various positions and cover
- Efficient weapons manipulation skills
- Malfunction clearances
- Understanding wound ballistics
- Tactics and techniques for fighting with the carbine
- Extended range shooting
- Low light / night techniques
- Use of optical sights.
